

#### U15 & U17 Boys

- A. The format for the U15 & U17 Boys competition is composed of:
  - a. Group stage;
  - b. Final match -> Between the 1st and 2nd places.
    - i. If the **score is still tied at the end of extra time**, the winner shall be decided by the taking of **kicks from the penalty mark** in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game.

#### U15 & U17 Girls

- A. The format for the U15 & U17 Girls competition is composed of:
  - a. Group stage;
  - b. Semi final stage;
    - i. If the **score is still tied at the end of regulation time**, the winner shall be decided by the taking of **kicks from the penalty mark** in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game.
  - c. Final match -> Between the winners of the semi finals.
    - i. If the score is still tied at the end of extra time, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game.

#### Senior Men's

- A. The format for the Senior Men's competition is composed of:
  - a. Qualification Round -> Between the two lowest ranked teams based on last year's MMSL Outdoor season. Winner will advance to the group stage
  - b. Group stage;
  - c. Semi final stage;
    - i. If the **score** is still tied at the end of regulation time, the winner shall be decided by the taking of **kicks** from the penalty mark in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game.
  - d. Final match -> Between the winners of the semi finals.
    - i. If the **score** is still tied at the end of extra time, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game.

#### Master Men's

- A. The format for the Master Men's competition is composed of:
  - a. Final match
    - i. If the score is still tied at the end of extra time, the winner shall be decided by the taking of kicks from the penalty mark in accordance with the FIFA Laws of the Game.
