

# MANITOBA SOCCER ASSOCIATION ARCHIE NUNN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



### SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The Archie Nunn Scholarship shall be awarded by the Manitoba Soccer Association to any successful applicant(s) who have for three or more years participated in programs sanctioned by the Manitoba Soccer Association and who are currently participating in some capacity of sanctioned soccer. Funds for the Scholarship are donated by associations, corporations, and private individuals to the Archie Nunn Memorial Fund. The amount of funding and number of scholarships to be awarded will be determined by the selection committee.
- 2. A Scholarship may be awarded to:

(a) Students proceeding from Grade 12 to any University in the Province or other post secondary institutions approved by the Scholarship Committee and/or...

- (b) Students already attending post secondary institutions, but who are under 18 years of age as of January 1st of the current year.
- 3. Candidates must complete the application in full and provide all the required information, documents, and letters for their application to be considered.
- 4. Scholarships may be conditional in that funds will be withheld until such time as the recipient provides proof that he/she is attending a post secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee.
- 5. A candidate must have proficiency in soccer as indicated by his/her play or have shown worthwhile contributions as judged by the Scholarship Committee, in refereeing, coaching or administration of the game of soccer.
- 6. A candidate must demonstrate good citizenship, character, and leadership.
- 7. The following must accompany the application before the application will be considered:

  (a) A letter from the Principal or Post Secondary Administrator certifying the candidate's age, character, and participation in school activities.
  (b) A final transcript of the student's marks for grades 10, 11, 12 or a certified photocopy of the Permanent Record Card. If neither is available a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the Principal or Post Secondary Administrator's signature will be accepted.
  (c) A letter from a Coach or Manager indicating the candidate's character, leadership, participation in community activities as well as information regarding the candidate's soccer ability or contribution to refereeing, coaching or administrative involvement.
- Note: It is the responsibility of the candidate to ensure that the application is complete and that all required information, documents and letters are enclosed with the application. Failure to provide ALL the required documents and/or information will result in disqualification. Please feel free to include any other attachments or information regarding the questions in the application.
