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Dear MSA Members,

The provincial health authorities announced that both indoor and outdoor amateur sports may return to full participation with restrictions only related to spectators, but recommendations to continue to be vigilant and careful.

The changes to the restrictions come into effect on August 7th.

This means that sanctioned soccer will remain in Stage 3 of the MSA RTP Protocols, as we still need to be careful and consider that the number of spectators at an outdoor or indoor sporting facility must not exceed 50% of the usual spectator capacity of the facility.

For indoor facilities measures must be in place to ensure that members of the public who are not engaged in sporting activities are reasonably able to maintain a separation of at least two metres from other members of the public while at the facility.

The MSA RTP protocols for outdoor and indoor have not been adjusted and the recommendations in Stage 3 continue to be part of the RTP protocols. Both the outdoor and indoor MSA RTP may be found at the following link:
