Dear MSA Members,

Based on the provincial health authorities' recent announcement that the province of Manitoba remains in the critical level (red) with no changes in the restrictions for the sport sector, in person sanctioned soccer activities will continue to be suspended in Manitoba until at least March 5th, 2021.

Please refer to the individual Member Leagues announcements for their decisions on the 2021 indoor competition season.

A reminder that the Manitoba Soccer Return to Play Guidelines coincide with the province of Manitoba's #RestartMB Pandemic Response System, and sanctioned soccer activities (Stage 1 or 2) can not resume until a provincial health region is moved into the restricted level (orange). Competition (Stage 3) will not be allowed to commence until a provincial health region is moved into the caution level (yellow).

We would also like to clarify the government's allowance of indoor facilities to now operate at 25% capacity for one-on-one instruction. As mentioned above, sanctioned soccer activities continue to be suspended in the province under the critical level (red), which includes one-on-one instruction.

We once again would like to thank the Members for continuing to provide virtual solutions to players, coaches, and referees. We commend everyone for the work they have put in thus far to keep their membership engaged, and we are hopeful that we will be able to return to the pitch soon safely.
