Dear MSA Members,

The provincial health authorities have announced changes to the restrictions for sport and recreation.

As of Friday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>:

- Indoor sporting and recreational facilities must not operate unless admission of members of the public to the facility is restricted to the following (Order 14-1):
  - persons who produce proof that they are fully immunized
  - persons who produce proof from the Government of Manitoba that there is a medical reason for the person not to receive a vaccine for COVID-19
  - o persons under 18 years of age
- This also applies to spectators who are watching sporting or recreational activities at the facility. (Order 14-2)

To clarify, this means that any adult over the age of 18 must provide proof that they are fully immunized to enter any indoor sporting and recreational facility. This includes players, coaches, referees, spectators, etc. The facilities will establish the process on how proof will need to be provided when entering the facility.

• If these orders require the operator of the facility to prevent members of the public who are not fully immunized from attending the facility, a person who is not fully immunized and who is not otherwise permitted to enter the facility under these Orders must not enter or attempt to enter that facility. (Order 25)

We continue to remind our members to ensure the MSA Return to Play protocols and the facility protocols are followed.
