Position Title: Canada Games Head Coach

Position Term: June 2020 – August 2021 (Volunteer Position)

Reports To: Manitoba Soccer Association Technical Department

Position Summary:

The Manitoba Soccer Association is accepting applications for the Canada Games Head Coach position. We are looking for individuals who are committed to providing a fun, safe, inclusive and competitive soccer environment for the top youth athletes in the province.

Position Description:

- Responsible for selecting an assistant coach and manager for the team (must be approved by the Manitoba Soccer Association, and recommendations may come from the Manitoba Soccer Association)
 - o *Assistant coach must have a minimum of a Canada Soccer B Part 1 License 'Certified' (180 days prior to the opening ceremonies (February 7, 2021))*
- Responsible for selecting the final roster and providing feedback to players who have not been selected
- Will follow the camp/training schedule that the Manitoba Soccer Association has set forth
- Will abide by the due dates for team selection set by the Manitoba Soccer Association
- Will attend the Canada Summer Games in the Niagara Region (August 6th – 21st, 2021 – will only be first or second week depending on gender coached)
- Must attend the scheduled meetings with Sport Manitoba
- Must be responsible (or assign it to assistant coach or team manager) for picking up equipment from the Manitoba Soccer Association or Sport Manitoba

Qualifications, Experience, Skills and Competencies:

- Minimum Canada Soccer B Part 2 License 'Certified' (180 days prior to the opening ceremonies (February 7, 2021))
- Minimum 3 years coaching experience, preferably with 15-18-year-old players
- Holds Sport Manitoba Respect in Sport & Making Ethical Decisions
- Holds a current Criminal Record & Vulnerable Sector Check
- Strong teaching, leadership, organization and communication skills
- Valid driver's license
